SPRING

PIERCE COLLEGE

PSYCH 001 - GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY

Students are introduced to the scientific study of behavior and mental processes through an examination of well-established psychological perspective theories, concepts, research methods and results.



CHILD DEV 001 - CHILD GROWTH AND DEV

Students are introduced to the theory of human development focusing on growth from conception through adolescence.

ASL 040 - INTRO TO DEAF CULTURE

In this course, students develop basic grammar and lexical proficiency in American Sign Language. Emphasis is placed on comprehension skills.



ASL 001 - AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE 1

In this course students develop basic grammar and lexical proficiency in American Sign Language. Emphasis is placed on comprehension skills.

CINEMA 107 - HISTORY MOTION PICTURE

Students examine a survey of motion pictures as a communication medium via screenings and lecture. Assigned readings analyze classics and contemporary films, American and foreign-made films, and theatrical and non-theatrical releases.



COMM 101 - PUBLIC SPEAKING

Students analyze the theory and techniques of public speaking in a democratic society. Students will discover, develop and critique ideas in public discourse through research, reasoning, organization, composition, presentation and evaluation of various types of speeches.

BUSINESS 1- INTRO TO BUSINESS

Students will study the basic areas of business in this survey course. Topics include: Accounting, International Business, Finance, Marketing, Management, Business Law, Business Organization, and Careers.



ADM JUS 001 - INTRO ADMIN OF JUSTICE

Students are introduced to the characteristics of the criminal justice system in the US, Focus is placed on examining crime management, theoretical explanations of crime, responses to crime, components of the system, and current challenges to the system.

COUN 040 - COLLEGE STRATEGIES

Develops students' learning strategies for college success. Examines and practices critical thinking, study methods, learning styles, time management, test preparation and test taking, and self-regulated learning.



SOC 001 - INTRO TO SOCIOLOGY

Examines basic concepts, theoretical approaches and methods of sociology. Emphasizes the analysis and understanding of social structure, social interaction, socialization and the self, social stratification, cultural diversity, social change and global dynamics.
